COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER OF FRANKLIN COUNTY TO HOLD 'CRUCIAL CATCH' KICK-OFF EVENT

GREENFIELD- The Community Health Center of Franklin County (CHCFC) will hold it's 'Crucial Catch' breast cancer kick off event on October 11th from 6-8p.m. at the Greenfield Community College Dining Commons. Women of all ages in the Franklin County and North Quabbin Area are cordially invited to attend. This event is absolutely free, dinner and give- away's provided in addition to great speakers including Sharleen Moffatt, breast cancer survivor.

The 'Crucial Catch' project will deploy a clinical community outreach team into Franklin County over the course of the next several months and educate women on the importance of early breast cancer screenings, services the health center provides, and educate them on the importance of regular office visits and screenings for cancer. The outreach team will consist of one of the health centers providers (a Doctor, N.P, or P.A) and a Nurse Educator who is well trained to provide clinical breast exams and educate women about additional clinical screenings and treatments. In addition, there will also be a mobile, but private on-site screening center set up. The goal of this project is to break the access barriers to health care and educate the community on the realities of breast health.
